Vancouver Recital Society presents acclaimed Argentinean pianist Ingrid Fliter

**(Vancouver, BC)** – Rising piano star, Ingrid Fliter, promises to light up the stage when she performs in a concert presented by the Vancouver Recital Society at the **Vancouver Playhouse on Sunday, November 4, 2007 at 8.00pm**. Her programme will include Haydn's *Sonata in E minor, Hob. XVI: 34*, Schubert's *Impromptu No. 2 in E-flat Major, Op. 90*, Beethoven's *Sonata in D, Op. 10, No. 3* and Chopin's *Nocturne in B Major, Op. 9, No. 3 & Sonata No. 3 in B minor, Op. 58*.

Fliter is generating the kind of 'buzz' reserved only for rare talent in the music world. She was one of three pianists tagged by Gramophone magazine as one of "Tomorrow's Classical Superstars" in its August 2006 issue. She was the 2006 winner of the prestigious Gilmore Award, which is bestowed every four years to an exceptional pianist who possesses broad and profound musicianship and charisma and the ability to sustain a career as a major international concert artist. Previous winners have included Piotr Anderszewski and Leif Ove Andsnes.

Described as "*a pianistic force of nature*" by The LA Times, Fliter has been noted for her fiery, passionate style and the natural sensitivity and elegance of her playing. She possesses a distinctly unique and imaginative approach which, combined with a compelling stage presence, makes for truly unforgettable performances.

Born in Buenos Aires in 1973, Fliter began her piano studies with Elizabeth Westerkamp. In 1992, at the suggestion of fellow Argentine Martha Argerich, Fliter moved to Europe where she continued her studies with Vitalij Margulis at the Musikhochschule fur Musik in Freiburg and subsequently with Carlo Bruno in Rome and at the Academy Incontri col Maestro in Imola under the leadership of Fanco Scala and Boris Petrushansky. She has also participated in master classes with Leon Fleischer, Alexander Lonquich and Louis Lortie and receives ongoing musical support and artistic advice from Zoltan Kocsis.
